Subject: Request for Assistance, preliminary requirements

Date 24.9.2019

1. General Description of the Situation:

On September 21, 2019 Albania was hit by a powerful earthquake, whose shocks were felt all over the territory. According to the Institute of Geoscience, Energy, Water and Environment/IGEWE on 16:04:20 has fallen an earthquake with magnitude, $M=5.8$, epicenter Kepi i Rodonit, 30 km in North of Durres (41.59° N, 19.5° E), depth 25 km.

According to IGEWE, there have been many aftershocks following the main event.

The most affected regions from earthquake are 7 prefectures/regions from 12 that we have in total like Durres and Tirana, Elbasan, Diber, Lezha, Fier and Berat,

Also, on September 23, 2019, we are facing with heavy rains that caused floods in some cities that are already affected by the earthquake.

In the regions of Shkodra, Lezha, Durres, Fier, Vlora, Gjirokastra and Berat we had during the night's continuous heavy rainfall in the form of thunderstorms accompanied by electric discharges.

2. Preliminary assessments of the damages caused due to earthquake:

- 2354 houses are reported damaged by citizens
- Only 1546 houses are identified/assessed by the Municipalities and Prefectures.
- 125 cracked palaces
- 34 cracked schools
- 2 health center
- 3 Warehouses
- 4 vehicles
- 4 power supply facility
- 5 bridges damaged

3. Measures taken by the Albanian government:

All the operational structures are in operation to assist the affected population. Also municipalities have set up the Assessment Commissions, to identify one by one each house, building and other facilities in order to have the exact number and the value of the damages.

Also there are distributed manufactured materials (tents, blankets and pillow etc.) and items for first aid but the request is high compared to the reserves. Also we need external experts to assist our internal experts for assessment of the damages caused on the structure of the houses and other buildings.

4. Request for support

In the light of the emergency that our country is experiencing the Government has decided to request international assistance.

From our assessment and also lessons learned from past civil emergencies operations we conclude that the provision of the items listed below would enhance our capacities and capabilities to respond more efficiently to the effects caused by earthquake and the floods. Having said that, we would kindly ask to assist Albania as follows:
